#### Certificate of Log Provenance / Sustainability / Fire Reclamation:

Species: Douglas fir

Products: This certificate is valid across all Douglas fir products.

#### Origin:

All (100%) of our Douglas fir logs originate from post-fire reclamation/salvage or pre-fire thinning efforts around New Mexico. Specifically, our Douglas fir logs are being sustainably harvested or reclaimed on Tribal lands owned and managed by the Jemez Pueblo in Northern New Mexico. Additionally, some of our logs are being sourced on the New Mexico State Land Office's Cook's Peak Watershed Restoration Project or the USFS Black Lake Sustainable Thinning Site.

Due to the catastrophic wildfires endemic in the Rocky Mountains, most of Old Wood, LLC's log supplies used as raw materials for our wood flooring are coming from previously burned areas. As such, this wood should be considered as being fully fire-reclaimed. Though the logs are burned on the outside, our rigorous production and quality control processes ensure that only high-quality, solid wood is being used in our flooring.

Old Wood's Douglas fir log supply may also be salvaged from "beetle kill" areas across Northern New Mexico. In this case, dead or dying trees that would otherwise have no use are being harvested and reclaimed as raw materials for quality wood flooring material. As such, this material should also be considered "salvaged" or "reclaimed".

Old Wood, LLC is committed to the sustainability and proper utilization of our forests and watersheds. By using post-fire reclaimed/salvaged logs and scientific pre-fire thinning methods, we hope that our model will help prevent catastrophic wildfire and insect infestations that are too commonly destroying our forests, communities, and ecosystems.
